For all concerned who applied for “Purbachal Plot” from Australia and New Zealand and Fiji

After the completion of lottery to distribute plots among the applicants for “Purbachal Project”, the Rajdhani Unnayan Kartipakkha (RAJUK) of Bangladesh has decided to refund money to those who did not win the lottery for Purbachal Plot. For that purpose they have uploaded a form in their website (www.rajukdhaka.gov.bd/purbachal/index.htm). In the form it is required to submit a photograph of the applicant, which needs to be attested either by ‘Notary Public’ or ‘an Officer from Bangladesh High Commission’. Therefore, those who want their photograph to be attested by an officer of the High Commission are requested to do the following:

Please send your photograph to the Bangladesh High Commission in Canberra along with a self addressed return envelope. To facilitate our work you must send either a photocopy of your Passport or a photocopy of the affidavit, which was earlier attested by the High Commission for the same purpose.

It may kindly be noted that there will be no fees for this photo attestation service and it will not be rendered at Consular camps in Sydney and Melbourne.
